The eligibility criteria as per Maharashtra Government Gazette [Extraordinary Part Eight No. MAI-ÆNG 12009/35528, Extraordinary No. 14] In pursuance of Clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution of India, the following translation in English of the **Maharashtra State Skills University Act, 2021 (Maharashtra Act No. VII of 2021, Amendment as per the Maharashtra State Skills University (Amendment) Act, 2024 (Maharashtra Act No. XXXIII of 2024), published in the Maharashtra Government Gazette on 31st July 2024, deemed to have come into force on 16.03.2024). (First published, after having received the assent of the Governor in the “Maharashtra Government Gazette”, on the 23rd March 2021).**

Section 12 (3) The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor in the following manner:

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(f) A person recommended by the search-cum-selection committee for appointment as Vice-Chancellor shall, —

(i) be a person possessing highest level of competence, integrity, morals and institutional commitment;

(ii) be an eminent and distinguished academician and an administrator of high calibre with experience in skill education or employability based education or entrepreneurship promotion holding doctoral degree;

(ii-a) a minimum of ten years of experience as a Professor in any University or ten years of experience in a reputed research or academic administrative organisation with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership;

(iii) be able to provide vision; and have ability to translate the same into reality in the interest of students in society; and

(iv) possess such additional educational qualifications and experience as may be specified by the State Government, by an order published in the Official Gazette, in consultation with the Chancellor.
