SEARCH-CUM-SELECTION COMMITTEE INVITES APPLICATIONS FOR THE POST OF VICE-CHANCELLOR

The University of Mumbai (UoM) is one of the oldest and premier Universities in India, established in the year 1857. The University is recognized under Sections 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956 and is currently incorporated under the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016. UoM has Campuses at Fort and Vidyangari, Santacruz (East), Mumbai, and Sub-Campuses in Thane, Ratnagiri, and Sindhudurg Districts. UoM at present has 54 University Departments/Institutions/ Centers / Centers of Excellence, five Autonomous Departments, one Constituent College, and two Model Degree Colleges. UoM has seven jurisdictional districts viz. Mumbai (Mumbai City & Suburban area), Thane, Palghar, Raigad, Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg and, around 852 Colleges are affiliated with University out of which 54 are Autonomous, with more than eight lakh students. A transparent process is provided under the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 as amended as per Ordinance No. XIII of 2022, promulgated by the State Government in H&TED on 24th November 2022 for selection of the Vice-Chancellor which is aimed at selecting a distinguished academician with leadership and administrative abilities who would be able to transform the University into a Centre for Academic and Professional Excellence.

His Excellency, the Chancellor of the University of Mumbai & Governor of Maharashtra, has formed a four-member Search-cum-Selection Committee for recommending suitable names for the post of Vice-Chancellor of this University. The Search-cum-Selection Committee now invites applications/nominations from eminent academicians who fulfill the qualifications and experience prescribed under Section 11 (3)(f) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 for the post of Vice-Chancellor and who are willing to take on this challenging assignment. All the necessary details regarding essential qualifications and experience and application format together with (i) Summary Sheet (to be filled online and signed copy of the print) as (Annexure I) and (ii) No Objection and Vigilance Clearance Certificate as (Annexure II) are available on the University of Mumbai website www.mu.ac.in

The interested eligible candidates/applicants can apply for the post as per the format of the application together with (i) Summary (Annexure-I) and (ii) No Objection and Vigilance Clearance Certificate (Annexure II) with all requisite documents arranged chronologically (in .doc and .pdf format). Additionally, they should provide a write-up about their suitability for the post, a write-up about their vision for the University, and the name and contact details of the three referees (distinguished individuals well acquainted with the work of the applicant) along with reference letters.
